



In the Matter of the land by Derwenlas  
Rhostryfan in the parish of Llanwnda

---

DECISION

This reference relates to the question of the ownership of the land by Derwenlas Rhostryfan in the parish of Llanwnda being the land comprised in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 54 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Caernarvonshire County Council of which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

Following upon the public notice of this reference Mrs L D Wright claimed to be the freehold owner of the land in question and no other person claimed to have information as to its ownership.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership of the land at Bangor on 25 March 1981.

Mrs Wright was represented at the hearing by Mr H Williams, local Secretary of the National Farmers Union, but the documents of title produced at the hearing did not in my view establish her claim to ownership.

Three documents produced after the hearing were similarly inconclusive.

On this evidence I am not satisfied that any person is the owner of the land, and it will therefore remain subject to protection under section 9 of the Act of 1965.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
