

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 274/U/95

In the Matter of Land known as Cefn Bryntyrch Capel Curig

DECISION

This reference relates to the question of the ownership of land known as Cefn Bryntyrch Capel Curig being the land comprised in the Land Section of Register Unit Mo.CL.104 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Carnaryonshire County Council of which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

Following upon the public notice of this reference no person claimed to be the freehold owner of the land in question and no on claimed to have information as to its ownership.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership of the land at Bangor on 25 March 1981.

There was no appearance at the leaving.

In the absence of any evidence I am not satisfied that any person is the owner of the land, and it will therefore memain subject to protection under section ? of the Act of 1965.

I on required by regulation 50 (1) of the Tommone Commissioners Regulations 1971 to emploin that a person aggrieval by this decision as Tain, erroneous in joint of law may, within 5 weeks from the date on which notice of the Todision is sent to him require has to state a same for the decision of the Migh Isuat.
