

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 50/D/21

In the Matter of Land known as Rhos Porth Ychain, Penlloch, Tudweiliog.

## DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No VG 5 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Caernarvonshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No 36 made by Dr W.G.J. Hampson and noted in the Register on 15th July 1973.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Caernarvon on 30th January 1973. The hearing was attended by the Objector and by his Counsel Mr R.G.Woolley, instructed by Messrs. I, ap. G. Hughes & J Elwyn Williams, Solicitors, Caernarvon.

For the reasons appearing from my decision under the deference No 50/D/22 I refuse to confirm the registration.

I make no order for costs in this case, because it appears that Dr Hampson has no proprietory interest in the land.

I am required by regulation 50(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
