

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No 274/D/52-55 inclusive

In the Matter of Llechweddgain Common, Trawsfynydd, Merionnydd D

## DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry Nos 3, 4, 22 and 25 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No CL. 11 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Merioneth County Council and are occasioned by Objection No 88 made by R G Williams and noted in the Register on 22 October 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Dolgellau on 10 February 1977. The hearing was attended by Mr A M Dancer of Messrs Griffiths Adams and Williams on behalf of the Objector and by Mr F Mallows on behalf of the Forestry Commission.

The Applicants under Entry Nos 3,22 and 25 withdrew their claims to Rights and Mr Dancer withdrew the Objection to Entry No 4.

For these reasons I refuse to confirm the registrations at Entry  $^{\rm H}$ os 3, 22 and 25 and I confirm Entry  $^{\rm H}$ o  $^{\rm H}$ o.

I am required by regulation 50(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
