



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 54/D/64 and 65

In the Matter of Migneint Llanycil
Meirionnydd D.

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section and Entry No.1 in the Rights Section of Register Unit maintained by the Meirioneth County Council and is occasioned by Objection No.222 made by Lt Col.K J Price and noted in the Register on 18th December 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Dolgellau on 9th February 1977. The hearing was attended by Mr R J Thomas on behalf of Lt Col Price and Mr H David on behalf of the successor to the applicant for rights namely Mr G D Jones.

In the course of the hearing relating to the adjoining Unit No.CL.113 it was agreed between the parties that I should confirm the Entry in the Land Section of this Unit and confirm the Entry in the Rights Section modified so as to confer the right to graze 85 sheep over this unit and Lt Col Price's land Unit No.CL.113 but so that the number of sheep grazed at any one time on this unit and Unit No. CL.113 shall not exceed 15 sheep.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
