



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 274/D/69-70

In the Matter of Mynydd Ceunant Mawr
Llanegryn Meirionydd D

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Ownership Section of Register Unit No. CL.118 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Merioneth County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 491 made by Glyn Williams and noted in the Register on 13 September 1972, and objection No. 488 made by J G Evans and noted in the Register on 13 September 1972.

I held an adjourned hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Dolgellau on 14 December 1978. The hearing was attended by Mr J Williams of Messrs. Williams and Hancock on behalf of Mr J Williams an objector who claimed ownership of part of the land and also for Col J F Williams-Wynne who has claimed ownership at Entry No 1 in the Ownership Section of the Register.

Mr Douglas Williams of the N F U appeared for Mr J G Evans the other objector and withdrew Mr J G Evans objection.

Mr Williams stated that Col Williams-Wynne was content that I should modify his Entry in the Ownership Section by excluding any land to which Mr J Williams could show a good title.

Mr Williams produced a conveyance dated 1963 whereby the land edged red on the plan annexed to this decision was conveyed by the executors of Price to Rees and a conveyance dated 1969 whereby the said land was conveyed by the executors of Rees to Mr and Mrs Williams.

I am satisfied that Col Williams-Wynne is not the owner of the said land claimed by Mr and Mrs Williams and in the absence of any other objection I confirm the Entry modified by the exclusion of the land edged red on the plan annexed to this decision.

Mr Oliver-Jones Counsel instructed by Messrs. Hugh J Rowlands held a watching brief for Mr L R David who claimed grazing rights and who claimed his objection No. 487 was wrongly stated in the Register to have been withdrawn. Mr Davies is out of time for registering his claim for grazing rights and even if his objection to rights Entries 1 and 2 had not been withdrawn it will be of no avail for the purpose of securing him any grazing rights. Any rights he may have had are now extinguished.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
