



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No 274/D/91

In the Matter of Mynydd Glan-
llyn-y-Forwyn, and including
part of Y-Llethr, Meirionnydd D

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No CL. 203 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Merioneth County Council and is occasioned by Objection No 273 made by the Merioneth Branch of the National Farmers Union and noted in the Register on 16 April 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Dolgellau on 19 April 1977. The hearing was attended by Mr D Williams on behalf of the National Farmers Union who produced a signed consent by Mr Alan Mattingly withdrawing the Registration made by the Ramblers' Association.

For this reason I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 50(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
