



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference Nos 274/D/165 to 174 inclusive

In the Matter of Seashore and
Saltings above ordinary High Water
mark at Red Wharf Bay and
Llandbna Beach, Pentreath and
Llanddona, Ynys Mon BC

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No A 42 in the Land Section of Register Unit No CL. 42 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Anglesey County Council and are occasioned by the Objections set out in the Schedule to this decision.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Llangefni on 23 March 1977. The hearing was attended by Mr E L Gilson on behalf of Ynys Mon BC and Mr Forcer Evans on behalf of Sir Richard William Bulkeley Bt, one of the Objectors.

Ynys Mon BC is the successor to Aethwy RDC on whose application the Registration was made and Mr Gilson did not seek to uphold the Registration.

For this reason I refuse to confirm the registration.
