



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of Tywyn Llangadwaladr,
Llangaswaladr, Ynys Mon

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry Nos. 42-30 and 2 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL 7 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Anglesey County Council and is occasioned by Objection Nos. O/45 and O/47 both made by David Milligan and both noted in the Register on 29 September 1970 and the conflicting registrations at Entry Nos. 30 and 42 in the said Rights Section.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Bangor on 24 May 1979. The hearing was attended by Mr Milligan who informed me that Entry No. 42 was withdrawn and he invited me to confirm the conflicting Entry No. 30 and refuse to confirm Entry No. 42.

Mr Milligan informed me that Mr Owen Davies, the tenant applicant under Entry No. 2 had died and in the absence of any claim by a successor to Mr Davies' tenancy, I refuse to confirm Entry No. 2.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
