



In the Matter of Uwchgwyrfai Common (part)
in the parishes of Betws Garmon, Llandwrog and
Llanwnda

DECISION

This reference relates to the question of the ownership of land above mentioned being the land comprised in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL.16 in the Register of Common Land by the former Caernarvonshire County Council of which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

Following upon the public notice of this reference the Crown claimed to be the freehold owner of part of the land in question and no other person claimed to have information as to its ownership.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership of the land at Bangor on 25 March 1981.

Miss J Phillips appeared on behalf of the Crown Estate Commissioners and produced evidence that the Crown was the owner of the land coloured orange or red on the plan annexed thereto.

On this evidence I am satisfied that the Crown is the owner of those parts of the land coloured orange or red as aforesaid and I shall accordingly direct the Gwynedd County Council, as registration authority, to register the Crown as the owner of the land under section 3 (2) of the Act of 1965, the remainder thereof will remain subject to protection under section 9 of the Act of 1965.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
