

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No.274/D/135 & 136

In the Matter of Yr Alltwen Penmaenmawr

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section and Entrys 3-11 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No.CL.10 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Caernarvonshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 108 made by British Railways and noted in the Register on 30 September 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Caernarfon on 16 February 1977, The hearing was attended by Mr J Joyce of Messrs. Elwyn Jones and Co., on behalf of British Railways.

British Railways are the owners of a strip of land across the North East of the land which is a tunnel and the surface over it. There was rightly no objection to the exclusion of this railway land from the common and I confirm the Entry in the Land Section modified so as to exclude the Railway land identified on the plan annexed to its Objection No. 108 and I confirm the Entrys in the Rights Section as applicable to the modified Entry in the Rights Section.

I am required by regulation 39 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
