



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No 274/D/18, 33, 34 & 35

In the Matter of Yr Eifl Pistyll,
Dwyfor D

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No VG. 21 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the former Caernarvonshire County Council and are occasioned by the conflicting registrations at Entry Nos 1 in each of the Land Sections of Register Units Nos CL. 70 and CL. 73 in the Registers of Common Land maintained by the Council.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Pwllheli on 26 May 1976. The hearing was attended by Mr E Williams, clerk to the Pistyll Community Council.

Mr Williams had no evidence to support the registration of the land in question as a Town or Village Green, and accepted that the land is not a Town or Village Green as defined by the Act of 1965.

For these reasons I refuse to confirm the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Unit No VG. 21.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
