



In the Matter of Bramdean Common (part),  
Bramdean, Hampshire.

## DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 5 in the Land section of Register Unit No. CL 117 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Hampshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. OB 303 made by Mr E W Silk and noted in the Register on 6 November 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Winchester on 23 February 1977. The hearing was attended by Mr Neil Jenkinson, solicitor, on behalf of Mr A N Dowling, the applicant for the registration, and by Mr G L Cox, solicitor, on behalf of Mr Silk.

The land comprised in the Register Unit consists of an area of about 104 acres and a small triangular detached area lying to the south-west of the main part of the land. The Objection relates only to the triangular area. Mr Jenkinson informed me that Mr Dowling did not wish to support his application in so far as it related to the triangular area and he produced consents to the exclusion of this area from the Register Unit signed by all the applicants for registrations in the Rights section of the Register Unit.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration with the following modification:- namely the exclusion of the land the subject of the Objection.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
