

In the Matter of Bramshott Common (part)Bramshott East Hampshire D.DECISION

These disputes relate to the registrations at Entry Nos 1 17 6 9 10 13 14 & 15 in the Rights section of Register Unit No. CL.102 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Hampshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection Nos. OB459 and OB902 both made by The National Trust and respectively noted in the Register on 31 December 1970 and 3 August 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Winchester on 5 May 1978. The hearing was attended by Mr J Trimmer of Messrs. Bradley Trimmer and Co., on behalf of the National Trust, none of the applicants for rights appeared. Mr Trimmer informed me that the applicants under Entries No. 6 and 10 had withdrawn their claims and he also invited me to refuse to confirm Entry No. 9 and in the absence of the applicant I must accede to his invitation.

For these reasons I refuse to confirm Entry Nos 6 9 and 10 at Mr Trimmer's invitation. I confirm Entry Nos 1 17 13 14 and 15 modified as follows:-

ENTRY NO 1 By deleting all the words in column 4 and substituting therefor the words "The right to graze 4 horses and 6 geese and a right of estovers"

ENTRY NO 13 By deleting paragraphs 3 and 4 from column 4

ENTRY NO 14 By deleting paragraphs 2 3 and 5 from column 4

ENTRY NO 15 By deleting all the words in column 4 and substituting therefor the words "The right to graze 75 cattle and 2 ponies and a right of estovers"

Entry No 17 4 delete paras 2 & 4 from the 4th column

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
