DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section and Entry No.1 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No.CL.114 in the Register of Common Land maintained by Objection No. OB406 made by C E W Saunders (Odiham) Ltd and noted in the Register on 5th February 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Winchester on 4 May 1978. The hearing was attended by Mr E Mason on behalf of Hampshire County Council who registered the land as common land without application. Mrs Dixon the successor to the applicant for rights under Entry No. 7 in the Rights Section had by a letter dated 28 April informed the Objectors that she did not intend to pursue her claim for rights.

Mr Mason on behalf of the Registration Authority did not support the registration and invited me to refuse to confirm it.

For these reasons I refuse to confirm the registrations.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
