



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT, 1965

Reference No. 214/D/129-132

In the Matter of The Old Chalk Pit,
Long parish, Test Valley D

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section and the Entry at No 1 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No.CE.153 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Hampshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. OB 109 made by Hampshire County Council and noted in the Register on 10 September 1969, and the conflicting registration at Entry No 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No.VG.100 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Council.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Winchester on 24 July 1979. The hearing was attended by Miss A A Craig on behalf of Hampshire County Council which withdrew its objection, Mr J H Driver on behalf of Long Parish Council which had withdrawn its conflicting registration in the Land Section of Unit No.VG.100. Mr J W Cooke the applicant for Rights and J H H Spaul who registered the land as common land.

The objection and the conflicting registration having been withdrawn I confirm the Entry in the Land Section and the Entry in the Rights Section.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
