

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 14/U/68

In the Matter of The Recreation Ground Meonstoke Winchester C.C.

DECISION

This reference relates to the question of the ownership of land known as The Recreation Ground, Meonstoke Winchester C.C. being the land comprised in the Land Section of Register Unit No.VG.186 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Hampshire County Council of which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

Following upon the public notice of this reference no person claimed to be the freehold owner of the land in question and no one claimed to have information as to its ownership.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership of the land at Winchester on 2nd March 1976.

Commander F J Bridgwater Chairman of the Corhampton and Meonstoke Parish Council appeared but he had no information as to the ownership of the land in question.

In the absence of any evidence I am not satisfied that any person is the owner of the land, and I shall accordingly direct the Hampshire County Council, & registration authority, to register Corhampton and Meonstoke Parish Council as the owner of the land under section 8 (3) of the Act of 1965.

I am required by regulat on 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous. in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the ligh Court.

In the Matter of The Swing Site Meonstoke Winchester C.C.

DECISION

This reference relates to the question of the ownership of land known as The Swing Site Meonstoke Winchester C.C. being the land comprised in the Land Section of Register Unit No.VG.187 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Hampshire County Council of which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

Following upon the public notice of this reference no person claimed to be the freehold owner of the land in question and no one claimed to have information as to its ownership.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership of the land at Minchester on 2nd March 1976.

In the absence of any evidence I am not satisfied that any person is the owner of the land, and I shall accordingly direct the Hampshire County Council, as registration authority, to register Corhampton and Meonstoke Parish Council as the owner of the land under section 8 (3) of the Act of 1965.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may; within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
