



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No.214/U/4

In the Matter of Upper Green
Kingsley, East Hampshire D

DECISION

This reference relates to the question of the ownership of land known as Upper Green, Kingsley, East Hampshire D being the land comprised in the Land Section of Register Unit No.VG. 158 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Hampshire County Council of which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

Following upon the public notice of this reference Kingsley Parish Council claimed to be the freehold owner of the land in question and no other person claimed to have information as to its ownership.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership of the land at Winchester on 4th March 1976.

Mr. H.J. Haydon chairman of the Kingsley Parish Council appeared and produced a conveyance dated 18th May 1965 whereby the land in question was conveyed to his council by the Secretary of State for Defence.

On this evidence I am satisfied that Kingsley Parish Council is the owner of the land, and I shall accordingly direct the Hampshire County Council, as registration authority, to register Kingsley Parish Council as the owner of the land under section 8(2) of the Act of 1965.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
