

In the Matter of Breinton Common, Stretton Sugwas, Hereford and Worcester (No 2)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No CL 68 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Hereford and Worcester County Council and is occasioned by Objection No 4 made by Mr G Morgan-Jones and noted in the Register on 24 October 1969.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Hereford on 15 and 16 February 1978. The hearing was attended by Mr H Foster, the Clerk of the Stretton Sugwas Parish Council, the successor of the Eaton Bishop Parish Council, the applicant for the registration, and by Mr D M Halpern, solicitor, on behalf of the Objector.

For the reasons given in my decision in <u>In the Matter of Breinton Common, Stretton Sugwas (No 1)</u> (1978), Ref. Nos 215/D/189-200 I am not satisfied that the land comprised in this Register Unit is either waste land of a manor or subject to rights of common.

I therefore refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
