



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No 215/D/234

In the Matter of Climbing Jack Common,
Richards Castle, Leominster District,
Hereford and Worcester

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 6 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No CL. 88 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Hereford and Worcester County Council and is occasioned by Objection No 363 made by the Ministry of Agriculture Fisheries & Food and noted in the Register on 17 December 1970.

All the persons entitled to be heard at the hearing of this dispute have agreed upon the terms of the decision to be given by me and have sent to the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners particulars of such terms signed by or on behalf of all such persons, such terms being that the Commons Commissioners do refuse to confirm the registration.

I am satisfied that there is no person who, if a hearing were held, would be entitled to be heard upon giving his name and address to me and satisfying me that he had succeeded to the interest, or part of the interest of any other person.

I am willing to give a decision in accordance with the proposed terms and I accordingly refuse to confirm the registration.
