

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 215/D/130

In the Matter of Corse Lawn Common, Eldersfield, Malvern Hills D

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registrations at Entry Nos 22 and 26 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL 42 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Worcestershire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 69 made by Roy G Spry and noted in the Register on 27 May 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Worcester on 11 May 1979. The hearing was not attended by any person entitled to be heard. I received at the venue for the hearing a written request by the objector to confirm Entry No. 22 and to confirm Entry No. 26 modified so as to limit the grazing right to 11 sheep. The said written request was accompanied by a consent by the solicitors for the applicant under Entry No. 26 to the said modification.

For this reason I confirm the registrations Entry No. 26 modified so as to limit the grazing right to 11 sheep.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
