



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of Logaston Common,
Almeley, Leominster District,
Hereford and Worcester

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registrations at Entry Nos 1 and 2 in the Ownership Section of Register Unit No CL. 10 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Hereford and Worcester County Council and are occasioned by these Entries being in conflict.

All the persons entitled to be heard at the hearing of these disputes have agreed upon the terms of the decision to be given by me and have sent to the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners particulars of such terms dated 1 and 2 November 1976 and signed by or on behalf of all such persons, which terms are that I should refuse to confirm Entry No 2 made on the application of Mr H G Adams and confirm Entry No 1 made upon the application of the County Land Agent.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the disputes at Hereford on 9 November 1976. At the hearing, Hereford and Worcester County Council were represented by Mr Bownes, their solicitor.

Mr Bownes informed me of the agreed terms. There is no reason why I should not give effect to them. I accordingly refuse to confirm the said Entry No 2 and confirm the said Entry No 1 without any modification.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
