



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of Malvern Link Common,

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 2 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No CL. 19 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Worcestershire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No 38 made by the Malvern Hills Conservators and noted in the Register on 16 November 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Worcester on 16 June 1976. The hearing was attended by Mr J D Schooling on behalf of the Malvern Hills Conservators and by Mr Wade solicitor on behalf of the applicant for rights. The applicant for rights has made applications under Units CL. 16 and CL. 29 which Mr Wade agreed are all in respect of the same animals; Mr Schooling agreed that the applicant should be entitled to graze 100 sheep or 20 cattle or 20 horses on this Unit and Units Nos CL. 16 and CL. 29. I therefore confirm Entry No 2 modified by substituting for all the words in column 4 the following words - viz:

"The right to graze 100 sheep or 20 cattle or 20 horses on this Unit and Units CL. 16 and CL. 29 but so that the number of animals grazed on this Unit and CL. 16 and CL. 29 at any one time shall not exceed the number stated above."

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
