



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No.215/D/9 and 10

In the Matter of Moor Meadow,
Bridstow, South Hereford D.

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registrations at Entries Nos 1 and 2 in the Ownership section of Register Unit No.CL.32 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Herefordshire County Council and is occasioned by the said conflicting registrations at Entry Nos 1 and 2 in the Ownership section of this Register Unit.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Hereford on 12 May 1977. The hearing was attended by Miss Margaret Warren on behalf of the South Hereford District Council the successor to Mr M A Power who claimed ownership under Entry No. 1 and Mr Holliday of Messrs.Knight Frank and Rutley, agents for Mr Charles Clore who claimed ownership under Entry No. 2. Miss Warren withdrew the District Councils claim to ownership and Mr Clores claim is therefore undisputed.

For these reasons I refuse to confirm the registration at Entry No. 1 and I confirm the registration at Entry No. 2.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
