



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No 215/D/102

In the Matter of Piece of land in  
the Parish of Colwall, Malvern Hills D

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 3 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No CL. 15 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Worcestershire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No 34 made by the Malvern Hills Conservators and noted in the Register on 13 November 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Worcester on 16 June 1976. The hearing was attended by Mr J D Schooling on behalf of the Malvern Hills Conservators and by Mr Ballard in person. Mr Ballard has claimed the same rights over this Unit and also Unit Nos CL. 14 and CL. 16. Mr Ballard accepts that these claims are duplicated and Mr Schooling agreed that he shall have the right to graze 43 stints over all or any of the three said Units. I therefore confirm the Entry at No 3 modified by substituting in lieu of all the words in column 4 the following words viz

"The right to graze 43 stints, of 10 sheep or 2 cattle or 2 horses over this Unit and CL. 14 and CL. 16 but so that the number of animals grazed at any one time over all or any of the said three Units shall not exceed 43 stints."

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
