



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of The Castle Greens, Longtown,  
South Herefordshire District, Hereford and  
Worcester County

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. VG.30 in Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Hereford and Worcester County Council and is occasioned by Objection No.453 made by the County Surveyor and noted in the Register on 21 January 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Hereford on 11 June 1974. At the hearing the County Council was represented by Mr G.H. Holman and Mrs M. Brierley, on whose application the registration was made, attended in person. Mr Holman said that the County Surveyor might withdraw the objection and that an application would then be made for a consent order; accordingly with the consent of Mrs Brierley, I adjourned the proceedings.

All the persons entitled to be heard at the hearing of this dispute have agreed upon the terms of the decision to be given by me and have sent to the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners particulars of such terms signed by or on behalf of all such persons, which terms are that the Commons Commissioner be requested to confirm the registration of the above land as Village Green.

I am willing to give a decision in accordance with the proposed terms and I accordingly confirm the registration without any modification.
