

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

215/D/145 & 146

In the Matter of Wilton Common, Ross on Wye and Ross Rural South Herefordshire D.

DECISION.

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No.1 in the ownership section of Register Unit No. CL.205 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Herefordshire County Council and is occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No.2 in the ownership section of the said register.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Hereford on 24th June 1975. The hearing was attended by Mr. R.Okell of Messrs. Okell & Okell, solicitor for Mr. M.A. power who made the Entry No 1 aforesaid Sir Charles Clore who made the Entry No 2 aforesaid withdrew his claim to ownership.

For this reason I confirm the registration at Entry No.1.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
