



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 15/D/29

In the Matter of Wilton West  
Bridstow, South Herefordshire D.

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Ownership Section of Register Unit No. VG.8 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the former Herefordshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 472 made by Mr and Mrs. T. Meredith and noted in the Register on 31st July 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Hereford on 24th June 1975.

The hearing was attended by Mr. R. Okell of Messrs. Okell and Okell, Solicitors for Mr. M.A. Power who made the Entry No. 1 aforesaid and by Mr. C. Sara, Counsel instructed by Messrs. Dolman's Solicitors for L.G. and P. Nanton the successors to the objectors.

The objection was made in the belief that the land in question was comprised in the land conveyed to the objectors, but Mr. Sara having had the opportunity of examining all the relevant deeds felt unable to pursue this claim.

Mr. Okell produced a conveyance dated 26th February 1968 whereby the Board of Governors conveyed to Mr. Power the Manor of Milton on Wye and all waste land if any then enjoyed with or reputed to be parcel of the Manor, and the Tithe map for the parish of Bridstow which included the land in question. It was not disputed that the land in question was at all material times waste or that the whole of the parish of Bridstow was within the Manor of Milton on Wye.

For these reasons I confirm the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Ownership Section of the Register.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
