COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965



Reference No. 216/D/55

In the Matter of Land in front of St Peter's Church, Tewin, Hertfordshire.

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL 147 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Hertfordshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 72 made by the Tewin Parish Council and noted in the Register on 3 September 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Hertford on 27 October 1982.

Before the hearing there was sent to the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners by the Clerk to the Parish Council a document which asked me to confirm the registration at Entry No. 147 in the Rights Section of the Register Unit. There is no such entry, so I was unable to give a decision under reg. 31 of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 (S.I. 1971 No.1727) even though the only entry in that section is Entry No. 1 and there was enclosed with the document a compliments slip on which was written "Enclosed to withdraw our objection to CL. 147". However, Mrs P Brown, the Clerk of the Parish Council, attended the hearing and informed me that it was desired not to pursue the Objection.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
