



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of Pound Land,
Sacombe, East Hertfordshire
District, Hertfordshire

DECISION

This reference relates to the question of the ownership of land known as Pound Lane, Sacombe, East Hertfordshire District being the land comprised in the Land Section of Register Unit No CL. 185 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Hertfordshire County Council of which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

Following upon the public notice of this reference East Hertfordshire District Council with a letter dated 24 May 1978 enclosed a photocopy of the Authority's terrier map for Sacombe showing edged and hatched red land in the ownership of her Authority. No person claimed to be the freehold owner of the land in question and no other person claimed to have information as to its ownership.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership of the land at Hertford on 8 June 1978. The hearing was attended by Mr W R Hare who is the chairman of Sacombe Parish Meeting.

Mr Hare said (in effect):- The land in question although it adjoins one of the two pieces edged and hatched red on the map enclosed with the said District Council letter is not part of either. The Villagers make use of the land and keep it tidy. There was no record of it ever having been conveyed to the Parish Meeting. He could offer no evidence of ownership.

In the absence of any evidence I am not satisfied that any person is the owner of the land, and it will therefore remain subject to protection under section 9 of the Act of 1965.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
