

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 264/D/26

In the Matter of Becksides, Bishop Wilton, Humberside (No.2)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No.CL.75 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Humberside County Council and is occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. VG. 58 in the Register of Town or Village reens maintained by the Council.

held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Beyerly on 15 January 1979. The hearing was attended by Mr John Jepson, Assistant solicitor of the Humberside County Council. Both the registration and the conflicting registration were made by the former East Riding of Yorkshire County Council as registration authority without application. Mr Jepson informed me that the Sumberside County Council did not wish to support the registration.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.
