DECISION

is dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land section of gister Unit No. VG. 58 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the mberside County Council and is occasioned by the conflicting registration at try No 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No.CL.75 in the Register of mmon Land maintained by the Council.

held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Beverley on January 1979. The hearing was attended by Mr John Jepson, Assistant solicitor the Humberside County Council. Both the registration and the conflicting gistration were made by the former East Riding of Yorkshire County Council as gistration authority without application.

Jepson informed me that the Humberside County Council did not wish to support the nflicting registration.
