



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference Nos. 264/D/33-34

In the Matter of Egremont, Land of Nod,
Holme upon Spalding Moor, Humberside (No 2)

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No CL 73 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Humberside County Council and are occasioned by Objection No 22 made by Mr and Mrs H Reader and noted in the Register on 13 July 1972 and Objection No 40 made by the Yorkshire River Authority and noted in the Register on 25 August 1975.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Beverley on 7 January 1979. The hearing was attended by Mr J Green, Solicitor, on behalf of the Personal Representatives of the late Mr Frank Laverack, the applicant for the registration, Mr K Simpson, Solicitor, on behalf of the Yorkshire Water Authority, and Mr J E Eade, the Chairman of the Holme upon Spalding Moor Parish Council. There was no appearance by or on behalf of Mr and Mrs Reader.

Mr Simpson informed me that he was instructed not to pursue Objection No 40.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration.

As required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 I explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
