

OMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of Elloughton Village Green, Elloughton Humberside

DECISION

his reference relates to the question of the ownership of land known as lloughton Village Green, Elloughton, being the land comprised in the Land ection of Register Unit No. VG. 48 in the Register of Town or Village Greens aintained by the Humberside County Council of which no person is registered nder section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

ollowing upon the public notice of this reference no person claimed to be the reehold owner of the land in question and no one claimed to have information as to ts ownership.

held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership the land at Beverley on 17 January 1979.

the hearing the Elloughton Parish Council was represented by Mr A W Kellington, its airman, who informed me that he had no evidence as to the ownership of the land question.

the absence of any evidence I am not satisfied that any person is the owner of the and, and I shall accordingly direct the Humberside County Council, as registration thority, to register the Elloughton Parish Council as the owner of the land under ection 8 (3) of the Act of 1965.

am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law y, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, quire me to state a Case for the decision of the High Court.
