



In the Matter of Figham, Beverley,  
Humberside (No. 3).

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Rights section of Register Unit No. CL 30 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Humberside County Council and are occasioned by the conflicting registrations at Entry No. 1 in the Land sections of Register Units Nos VG 51 and VG 52 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Council.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Hull on 23 and 24 March 1977 and at Watergate House, WC2 on 17 May 1977. The hearing was attended by Mr Patrick Ground, of counsel, on behalf of The Pasture Masters, The Freemen and Widows of Freemen of the Borough of Beverley, the applicants for the registration and the conflicting registrations.

Mr Ground informed me that his clients did not wish further to support the conflicting registrations.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
