



In the Matter of The Village Common, Great Hatfield,
Humberside

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No CL 38 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Humberside County Council and is occasioned by Objection No 5 made by Mr M K Spratt and noted in the Register on 5 November 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Beverley on 16 January 1970. The hearing was not attended by any person entitled to be heard. However, before the hearing the Clerk of the Great Hatfield Parish Council, the applicant for the registration, sent to the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners a copy of a letter dated 26 January 1978 in which the Objector stated that he had no further claim to the land.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
