

MMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of The Village Green, Thornton, Humberside

is reference relates to the question of the ownership of land known as The Village een, Thornton, being Mand comprised in the Land Section of Register Unit No. VG. 34 in e Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Humberside County Council which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 65 as the owner.

llowing upon the public notice of this reference no person claimed to be the eehold owner of the land in question and no one claimed to have information as its ownership.

held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership the land at Beverley on 15 January 1979.

the hearing, the Thornton Parish Council was represented by its Clerk, the Rev. F Johnson, who informed me that he had no evidence as to the ownership of the land question.

the absence of any evidence I am not satisfied that any person is the owner of the und, and I shall accordingly direct the Humberside ounty Council, as registration thority, to register the Thornton Parish Council as the owner of the land under ection 8 (3) of the Act of 1965.

an required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law ay, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, equire me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
