

OMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of The Village Green, Wold Newton, Humberside

DECISION

his reference relates to the question of the ownership of land known as The illage Green, Wold Newton, being the land comprised in the Land Section of Register nit No. VG. 30 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Humberside ounty Council of which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons egistration Act 1965 as the owner.

ollowing upon the public notice of this reference the Wold Newton Parish Council laimed to be the freehold owner of the land in question and no other person claimed have information as to its ownership.

held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership f the land at Beverley on 15 January 1979. At the hearing the Parish Council was epresented by Mr R Goodbody, its Chairman, who informed me that he had no evidence s to the ownership of the land in question.

n the absence of any evidence I am not satisfied that any person is the owner of ne land, and I shall accordingly direct the Humberside County Council, as registration athority, to register the Wold Newton Parish Council as the owner of the land under action 8 (3) of the Act of 1965.

am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law ay, within 6 weeks from the date on which this decision is sent to him, require means state a case for the decision of the High Court.
