

In the Matter of Pound Green, Calbourne,
Isle of Wight

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 31 in the Iand section of Register Unit No. CL 14 in the Register of Common Iand maintained by the Isle of Wight County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. CL/OBJ/3 made by the executors of Mr F H Reed, deceased and noted in the Register on 14 May 1971, Objection No. CL/OBJ/4 made by Mr E G Feben and Ms E P Feben and noted in the Register on 10 January 1972, and Objection No. CL/OBJ/5 made by Mr J R Rice and noted in the Register on 28 April 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Newport on 17 November 1977. The hearing was attended by Mr W J Eldridge, solicitor, on behalf of the executors of F H Reed, deceased, and by Mr D C Blundell, solicitor, on behalf of the other Objectors. There was no appearance by or on behalf of Mr H J Birch, the applicant for the registration.

There being no evidence to support it, I refuse to confirm the registration,

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
