



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of Ewell Minnis and Scotland Common.
Temple Ewell with River, Kent (No.2).

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No.1 in the Rights section of Register Unit No.CL 33 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Kent County Council and is occasioned by Objection No.8 made by Miss J.H.Loring and Mrs C.M.R.Brown and noted in the Register on 11th September 1969.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Canterbury on 16th November 1972 and at Dover on 20th November 1975. The hearing was attended by Mr Ian Romer and Mr T.J.Forbes, of counsel, on behalf of the Temple Ewell with River Parish Council, the applicant for the registration, and by Mr N.Hague, of counsel, on behalf of the Objectors.

For the reasons given in my decision in In the Matter of Ewell Minnis and Scotland Common, Temple Ewell with River (No.1) I am not satisfied that the rights claimed exist, and I therefore refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
