



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 220/D/295-297

In the Matter of Bentley Moss,
Rossendale B

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section and Entry No. 1 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL 279 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Lancashire County Council and is occasioned by Objections Nos. 324 and 366 made by Bolton County Borough Council and noted in the Register on 23 May 1972 and 29 June 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Preston on 17 November 1982. The hearing was not attended by any person entitled to be heard except Mrs P Clementson, representing the Registration Authority.

The registration in the Land Section was made in consequence of an application to register rights made by Barbara Jones, Elizabeth Hulme and Nora Entwistle. The Objection relates to part only of the land, and I understand that Northwest Water Authority is successor authority to the Objector.

The application to register was supported by the usual statutory declaration, and in the absence of evidence by the Objector, I shall confirm the registrations.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
