

In the Matter of Champion, Grindleton, Lancashire (NO.1)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registrations at Entry Nos. 2 and 3 in the Rights section of Register Unit No.CL.259 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Lancashire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 1701 made by Mr Jack Howard and noted in the Register on 4 July 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Blackburn on 19 June 1984. The hearing was not attended by any person entitled to be heard, but Solicitors acting for the Objector informed the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners by letter dated 14 June 1984 that the Objection would not be pursued.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
