



In the Matter of Champion, Grindleton, Lancashire (NO.2)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Ownership section of Register Unit No.CL.259 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Lancashire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 174 made by Mr Jack Howard and noted in the Register on 10 July 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Blackburn on 19 June 1984. The hearing was not attended by any person entitled to be heard, but Solicitors acting for Lord Clitheroe, the applicant for the registration, informed the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners by letter dated 8 June 1984 that it was agreed that the land the subject of the Objection ought to be excluded from the registration.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration with the following modification namely, the exclusion of the land shown edged red on the plan attached to the Objection.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
