DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No.CL.124 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Lancashire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 298 made by Mr G C Harries and Mr R G Swainson and noted in the Register on 5 May 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Lancaster on 17 July 1984. The hearing was attended by Mr R M N Gillibrant, Solicitor, on behalf of Mrs A Parker and Mr E Parker, the successors in title of Mr T Parker, in consequence of whose application for the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Rights Section of the Register Unit this registration was made, and by Mr N Le Poidevin of Counsel, on behalf of the Royal Society for ; the Protection of Birds, the successor in title of the Objectors.

It was agreed that I should confirm the registration, which I accordingly do.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous <u>in point of law</u> may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
