



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 20/U/36

In the Matter of Downall Green,

Ashton-in-Makerfield U.D.

Lancashire.

DECISION

This reference relates to the question of the ownership of land known as Downall Green, Ashton-in-Makerfield Urban District, being the land comprised in the Land Section of Register Unit No. C.L.51 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Lancashire County Council of which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

Following upon the public notice of this reference no person claimed to be the freehold owner of the land in question and no person claimed to have information as to its ownership.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership of the land at Preston on 7th June 1972.

No person attended the hearing and I therefore heard no evidence.

For this reason I am not satisfied that any person is the owner of the land, and accordingly the land falls into protection under section 9 of the Act.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
