DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. CL 223 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Lancashire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 108 made by the Executors of William Bargh, deceased.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Lancaster on 1 March 1978. The hearing was attended by Mr W D Molyneux, solicitor, on behalf of the Bolton-le-Sands Parish Council, the applicant for the registration. There was no appearance on behalf of the Objectors, but I was informed by solicitors on behalf of Mr J H E Cousins and Mrs S A Cousins, the successors in title to the Objectors in the property formerly known as Beach House, that the Objection was not being pursued.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
