



In the Matter of Knowl Moor, Rochdale B

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 14 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL 162 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Lancashire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 167 made by B and J Ovenden and noted in the Register on 7 July 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Preston on 8 December 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr B Ovenden and by Mr J T Thorpe, the applicant for registration at Entry No. 14. The Entry includes a right to graze 1500 sheep. The Objection is as to the number of animals and it was agreed by Mr Ovenden and Mr Thorpe that this should be reduced to 1250. Accordingly I confirm the registration modified by this reduction.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
