

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of Rimington Green, Rimington,
Lancashire (NO.2)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No.VG.66 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Lancashire County Council and is occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No.CL.270 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Council.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Blackburn on 19 June 1984. The hearing was attended by Miss E M Raby, the Clerk of the Rimington Parish Council, the applicant for the conflicting registration. There was no appearance by or on behalf of Mr P C Earl, the applicant for the registration. However, Miss Raby informed me that the Parish Council did not wish to pursue the conflicting registration, but wished to support the registration.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
