DECISION

This dispute relates to the registrations at Entry Nos. 1 to 8, 10 and 12 in the Rights section of Register Unit No.CL.4 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Lancashire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 20 made by Mrs J Lord and noted in the Register on 4 December 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Blackburn on 20 June 1984. The hearing was attended by Mrs Lord in person.

The Objection relates only to a very small area of land, which will be excluded from the Register Unit in consequence of my decision in <u>In the Matter of Salesbury and Computer Green Commons, Salesbury (NO.1)</u> (1984) Ref: Nos. 220/D/323-324.

In these circumstances I confirm the registrations.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
