



In the Matter of Salesbury and Copster Greens,
Salesbury, Lancashire

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No.VG.49 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Lancashire County Council and is occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No.CL.4 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Council.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Blackburn on 20 June 1984. The hearing was attended by Mr P Timson, Solicitor, on behalf of the Ribble Valley Borough Council, the successor authority of the former Blackburn Rural District Council, the applicant for the conflicting registration, and by Mr C H Frankland, a member of the Salesbury Parish Council. There was no appearance on behalf of the Ramblers' Association, the application for the registration.

There being no evidence to support the registration, I refuse to confirm it.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
